- Wildflower Creston is losing a teacher due to declining enrolment, some parents/students are moving on to new schools, celebrating with a camping trip wrap up next week
- BK wrap up, finished up plant sale
- MSSS had Aimee McKenzie youth mental health support worker, SART
- representative come to speak with them, invitation for school learning tours, grad class has been doing fundraising with a wellness fair last weekend, highlight is auctioning off a logging truck with firewood, giving bursaries to some grads - can also give non-traditional grants for training like first aid courses
- DESK still running garden club for the PAC, 22 children registered,
- CBESS mentorships for the secondary programs
- LVR student travel/field trips again, grateful with the transition of the principal this spring
- South Nelson basketball is alive and well there, 4x more players than Redfish at last game
